

Harvesting on order

It was hot and sunny towards the end of summer, resulting in an exceptional harvest, the longest - and most intensein the estate's history. Over the course of 16 days, our patience was tested to the limits while we awaited optimum ripeness and ideal balance in each grape variety and plot.

Authentic style

2023 is a typical 'Saint-Estephe' vintage in which Lilian Ladouys' hallmark identity truly shines. The crunchy, juicy Merlots are backed by deep, dense Cabernets, revealing a complete, delicious fresh wine of superb length. Ageing will further enhance its charm and exquisite generosity.
